- Before each use, check that the ladder is undamaged and safe to use.
- Do not use a damaged ladder.

- Do not use the platform without its guardrails or behind an unsecured door.
- The surfaces where the platform is placed must be horizontal and not slippery.
- All platform feet must be on the ground.
- On soft ground, it is essential to place a plate under all the feet concerned.
- Ensure that the work area is away from any live electrical conductors.
- The platform must not be thrown or handled roughly when in use.
- Always go up and down facing the platform.
- Do not climb onto the support section.
- Make sure you wear shoes that offer secure support.
- Do not stand on the platform if you feel vertigo or if you are tired.
- Do not use without stabilisers (see step 3).
- Do not use the platform to transport any object.
- When moving the product, make sure that the tool trays are empty, and nothing is placed on them.
- The guardrail locks must be locked when the product is in use.
- Remove tool trays when transporting on a roof rack.

*•The platforms are guaranteed against all manufacturing defects.
•The guarantee is limited to the repair, or the replacement of any article found to be defective.
Are excluded all product modified without agreement or damaged during transport or handling or
caused by inappropriate use.*

- Before each use, check the platform is in good condition.
- If parts need to be replaced, use only TUBESCA-COMABI components, see manufacturer's after-sales form section after-sales split view (see QRcode on the front).
- This platform must be inspected periodically and the results registered, see inspection sheet FV-02274 21 (see QRcode on the front).

- The platforms are mainly made of aluminium.
- Other materials such as steel, plastic and wood are integral parts of the product.
- At the end of the product's lifespan, it should be disposed of without sorting its materials.
- As the end consumer, you play an essential role in the reuse and recycling cycle.
- Make sure you take the product to an authorised waste collection center.
